Identify strategies for surviving disaster situations and improving life outcomes., Evaluate the environment in order to prioritize actions within the TECC phases of care., Analyze characteristics of a Direct Threat or Indirect Threat scenario., Describe aggressive hemorrhage control measures for severe bleeding to sustain life and prevent death., Apply appropriate tourniquet to support injured survivors., Apply positioning principles to support injured survivors., Demonstrate proper airway management techniques., Implement appropriate evacuation and reporting techniques when dealing with public safety officials., Apply strategies that can reduce psychological impact for First Care Providers.
