# **Aggressive Russian Scanning Targets U.S. Ports**

# **Background:**

Across the past eight weeks (12-April thru 05-June-2019), multiple U.S. Ports have reported *aggressive* scanning (rates as high as 200 scans per hour) for sustained periods (several days) from IP addresses which geo locate to *Russia*.

Even after the impacted organization blocked the IPs involved, scanning continued.

The MPS-ISAO has analyzed IP addresses associated with this activity, and continues to track and build blocklists for customers.
